



Ashford Walking instructions

Burgundy Trail

Distance 1.25 miles (2km)

1. 1st Ashford Boy Scouts HQ - Corner of Victoria Road - TN23 7HQ

Starting point; if you park in the Railway Station Car Park, walk over the bridge to the corner of Victoria Road and Beaver Road. Along this road was the site of the Scouts HQ.

2. 1 and 3 Russell Villas Beaver Road

Cross the road at the designated crossing. Russell Villas was on Beaver Road but we have not been able to locate so we have put on the corner.

3. 3 Beaver Road - Holtum family

Continue along Beaver Road, around the corner to number 3 Beaver Road.

4. 12 Lower Denmark Road - Denmark Arms

Continue to the junction of Lower Denmark Street and turn left onto Lower Denmark Street. Walk to number 12 on the bend, the site of the Denmark Arms.

5. 53 Lower Denmark Rd - The Brissenden

Walk further down Lower Denmark Street to number 53.

6. Post Office - 63 Beaver Road

Walk to the junction of Lower Denmark Street and Torrington Road. Turn right and walk to the junction of Christchurch Road, number 63 Beaver Road is on the corner.

7. Christchurch War Memorial

Cross Beaver Road with care to the Church, which is open during services.

8. 20 Christchurch Road – The Button family

Walk along Christchurch Road to number 20, which is on the right hand side.

9. 41 Christchurch Road - Alfred Barnes

Carry along Christchurch Road to number 41, which is on the left hand side.

10. 78 Christchurch Road - Hadaway family

Carry along Christchurch Road to number 78, which is on the right hand side.

11. Victoria Park

Walk to the end of the Christchurch Road and turn right. Cross over with care to Victoria park.

12. Allotment Gardens -Beaver Road

Walk straight ahead on the footpath in this area there would have been allotments.

13. Victoria Road Elementary School

Carry along the footpath until it meets Victoria Road, the school is across the road on the bend - cross with care

To return to the car park recommended route carry straight along the footpath to cross the railway. There is a long ramp for access so no need to use steps. Cross over the bridge and exit onto Elwick Road turn right back to the car park.
